- FEE PER EXHIBIT 50P ADULT, JUNIORS FREE
- Each exhibitor may only submit ONE entry per class
- No entry to have been submitted at any previous Tibenham show
- All exhibits in produce sections must be grown by the entrant
- All exhibits in Domestic, Arts and Crafts sections must be entrant's own work
- All entries must be delivered to the hall between 10am -12 noon on the day of the show. Exhibits may be viewed from 2 – 4pm
- No exhibits to be removed before 4pm on the day of the show
- The decision of the judges is final
- The Committee reserves the right not to be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits from any cause whatsoever
- \* We will host two workshops during the Summer for juniors to create items 36 and 37 at the Hall. Details to follow.
- \*\* Mystery bag entry: For something different, this year the Committee are providing adults and juniors with a bag of crafting materials to use in whichever way they choose, to create an exhibit to enter.
